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S&P 500 closes lower, weighed by declines in bank and retail shares

- Global markets. Dow Jones Industrial Average futures added 20 points, or 0.1%. S&P 500 and Nasdaq 100 futures also each climbed 0.1%. Retail stocks had been weak in Tuesday's session, but Urban Outfitters shares were nearly 6% higher in extended trading on the back of a betterthan-expected quarterly report. But La-Z-Boy slumped nearly 2% as management said furniture sales will "remain challenged." But the Nasdaq Composite eked out a 0.06% advance. The tech-heavy index was able to post a second day of gains despite selling pressure as investors readied for earnings from Nvidia, which was the biggest laggard on the index in Tuesday's session.
- In earnings news. Retail stocks Peloton, Foot Locker, Kohl's and Abercrombie & Fitch are due tonight before the bell, followed by artificial intelligence stock Nvidia and fellow technology company Snowflake after the market closes Thursday morning.

- In other markets. In a sign of how significant Wednesday's report will be, the options market is bracing for a move of 9.8 per cent following the results. With Nvidia accounting for nearly 3.2 per cent of the S&P 500 — a record-high weight for the company — the stock's move will have broader implications.
