## Stock futures inch higher as Wall Street comes off a losing week

- Global markets. The moves follow a losing week on Wall Street. The Nasdaq Composite and S&P 500 slid about 2.9% and 2.3%, respectively, marking their worst weeks since March. The Dow finished the week about 1.1% lower.
- In earnings news. Investors will watch on Monday for corporate earnings from companies such as Lucid, Palantir, Beyond Meat and Paramount. It's the latest leg of what has broadly been considered a better-than-expected season. Of the 84% of companies in the S&P 500 that have posted their quarterly results, about four-fifths have exceeded Wall Street forecasts, according to FactSet.
- In other markets, the USD closed lower against a basket of currencies (-0.47%), yields fell right along the curve (2-year -2.35%, 10-year -3.37%). Commodities were mixed, but mostly higher, with oil +1.11% to hold US\$82/bbl, gold and silver rose 0.5%~ each, uranium was modestly higher, copper was ~flat and tin lower rising by a strong 2.4%. Finally, the VIX Index rose ~7.28% on account of the day's equity market weakness.
- Futures ~flat. U.S. stock futures were about flat on Monday after the Dow Jones Industrial Average marked it's worst weeks since March. Australian shares are set to open up a little unchanged.
