## S&P 500 snaps 8 day winning streak, bond yields rise

 Global markets. The S&P 500 fell Thursday, ending an eight-day winning streak, as a sharp jump in yields rattled investors.

The benchmark index declined 0.81%, closing at 4,347.35, while the Nasdaq Composite lost 0.94% and settled at 13,521.45. The Dow Jones Industrial Average dropped 220.33 points, or 0.65%, to close at 33,891.94.

Stocks hit session lows after Federal Reserve Chair Jerome Powell indicated more work may need to be done to bring down inflation, although the recent slowdown in pace has been an encouraging sign for policymakers.

Disney rose 6.9% a day after reporting better-thanexpected profit and expanding its cost-cutting plan, while Arm dipped 5.2% following its first quarterly report as a public company. MGM Resorts slipped 1.1% even after posting strong results and a new share buyback program.

 In stocks and economic news. News Corp and Light & Wonder are poised to release earnings, while REA Group and Jupiter Mines are set to report sales data.

 In other markets. The yield on the US 10-year note spiked 13 basis points to 4.63 per cent at 3.09pm. The 30-year yield surged as much as 22 basis points.

Iron ore traded in Singapore closed above \$US125 a tonne. The outlook for the steel-making material has improved in part on hopes China is moving, albeit slower than some would hope, to bolstering the real estate sector.

 Futures. ASX futures were down 5 points or 0.1% to 7017 near 7am AEDT; they had been up more than 20 points earlier.
