Dow closes higher as hope that Fed is done raising rates, ASX to rise

 Global markets. Stocks rose Tuesday, resuming their November rally, as comments from a Federal Reserve official raised hope that the central bank may not need to raise interest rates further.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average added 92 points, or 0.3%, while the S&P 500 hovered just above flat. The tech-heavy Nasdaq Composite gained less than 0.1%.

Boeing led the Dow higher on Tuesday, adding 1.5%, while Dow-member retailers Nike and Walmart gained m0.8% and 1.2%, respectively. The S&P 500 got a lift from Newmont Corporation and Synchrony Financial, which were higher by 6.6% and 5.1%, respectively.

Stocks have rallied this month. The Dow and S&P 500 are on pace to finish the month 7.3% and 8.7% higher, respectively. The Nasdaq has climbed 11.1% in November.
