## ASX to rise, Dow rallies 500 points for best day since June, oil eases

• Global markets. Australian shares are poised to open higher to start the day. Shares were higher in New York, bolstered by a rebound in megacap techs. The Dow surged 511 points, 28 of its 30 components advanced, paced by Nike, Goldman Sachs and Verizon.

Tesla tumbled more than 5 per cent at one point, with sentiment hurt by concerns about its margin outlook and what appears to be the end of strikes by union workers at America's big three domestic automakers.

Some 162 S&P 500 companies (including four Dow 30 components) are scheduled to report results for the third quarter this week. Apple releases after the closing bell in New York on Thursday (Friday AEDT).

Origin Energy and Resolute Mining are set to report production results. Clinuvel Pharmaceutical, Data#3, Endeavour Group and Peter Warren Automotive host annual meetings. Shares of Autosports and Brickworks trade ex-dividend.

 In other markets. Oil has dropped back, putting a \$US100 a barrel target seemingly unreachable for the moment amid rising international pressure on Israel to rethink its bombing of Gaza.

US oil fell as much as 4.3 per cent, with losses accelerating after crude slipped below technical support levels near \$US82 a barrel.
