S&P 500, Nasdaq Composite trading in narrow range; ASX to edge up

 Global markets. The S&P 500 and the Nasdaq Composite ended Tuesday's session with modest gains as investors prepared for key inflation data to be released later this week.

The S&P 500 inched up 0.17% to 5,078.18. The Nasdaq added 0.37% to end at 16,035.30. The Dow Jones Industrial Average fell 96.82 points, or 0.25%, to close at 38,972.41.

Retail giant Macy's advanced 3.4% after announcing it would close around 150 of its struggling stores following a revenue miss in the prior quarter. Lowe's gained 1.7% after posting an earnings beat. Zoom Video and Hims & Hers Health rose 8% and 31%, respectively, following earnings reports that exceeded Wall Street expectations.

ANZ Research: "We expect the RBNZ to lift the OCR by 25bp to 5.75 per cent today as it continues to battle inflation. We are expecting an OCR track that shows the possibility of a follow up hike in April. We don't expect the RBNZ's medium term forecasts for either activity or inflation to have changed significantly, with the higher OCR track bringing about the prolonged period of subdued growth that is necessary to bring inflation down."

Overseas data: Eurozone February consumer and economic confidence data at 9pm; US fourth quarter GDP at 12.30am on Thursday AEDT

 In other markets. Crude oil futures rose Tuesday amid uncertainty about the prospects for a cease-fire in the Israel-Hamas war and as some investors expect OPEC+ will extend its production cuts beyond the first quarter.

The West Texas Intermediate contract for April rose \$1.21, or 1.56%, to \$78.79 a barrel. Brent April futures rose \$1.01, or 1.22%, to \$83.54 a barrel.
